Volunteers are needed to help present the PCAO 88-CRIME Crime Stoppers School program to 5th through 8th grade students at schools in and around Pima County.

The Program includes a PowerPoint, a short film, "Trouble at Hand" and a discussion. The film, produced by a local filmmaker examines a middle school student's conflict (to tell or not) when she overhears a classmate boasting that he is going to bring a gun to school.

Volunteers need to feel comfortable presenting to large groups of students and teachers.

Volunteers will be trained and need to be able to commit to a minimum of 8 hours a month, during the school day.
